

Buccaneer Camp Area Rules

Members (and regatta guests) are allowed to camp on the grounds only with previous permission from the Commodore.

No RV should be placed on Buc property without FIRST gaining permission from the Commodore.

RVs parked on Buc property with out permission will be assessed \$50 per week and will result in suspension of camping privileges.

- **Camping is only allowed in the Commodore approved designated camping area.**
- **RVs may only be occupied for a weekend or limited time as approved by the Commodore.**
- **Campers should work together to assure ample space and electricity is available for all campers. That being said, electricity and space is available by reservation with the Commodore. The Commodore has the right to restrict the number of campers on the property.**
- **Campers should be aware of the condition of the grounds and avoid making ruts or holes. All holes or ruts should be filled by the camper within one week of leaving or the camper will be assessed \$50 and the hole will be filled by a volunteer.**
- **Campers should remove all trash and empty any trashcans in the area when leaving.**
- **Campers should be respectful of other Buc's rights and not block boat access, particularly in the cat and small boat area.**
- **Campers will be assessed \$20 per week per RV or tent (This amount is independent of electricity usage). This is from the date the camper is dropped off on the property until it is removed. 1-7 days = 1 week, 8-14 days = two weeks, etc.**
- **No RV may be left on the property for more than two weeks. Any RV left on Buc property beyond two weeks will cause the member to receive a \$50 per week assessment.**
