House Rules

1. General

- 1.1. Members are expected to conduct themselves in a way that is not offensive to others. Vulgar or crude language is not permitted.
- 1.2. Members are accountable for the conduct of their guests.
- 1.3. Children are the responsibility of their parents and should be supervised appropriately for their age.
- 1.4. Members are expected to clean up after themselves and their guests.
- 1.5. All members are expected to empty the trash cans before they are completely full.
- 1.6. Damage to the club property by a member or their guest is the responsibility of the member.
- 1.7. If members are corrected on a rule and they disagree, then the members can appeal to a flag officer or board member. Still the members must abide by rule 1.1.
- 1.8. Junior members may have guests on the property only if accompanied and supervised by an Active, Associate, House, Life, or Spousal Member

2. Grounds

- 2.1. Illegal drugs are prohibited on club property, including the harbor.
- 2.2. No firearms are to be carried on club property except while being transferred to or from a member's boat.
- 2.3. All animals on the grounds must be leashed, licensed and up to date on all vaccines. Please clean up after your dog.
- 2.4. All cars, trucks and trailers must be parked in a manner that areas used commonly by all members are always accessible.
- 2.5. No vehicle or boat shall be parked and left unattended in the dry storage area in a manner that blocks the hoist area.

3. Bar and Clubhouse

- 3.1. No one under the age of 21 may be in the bar without a member 21 of age or over present.
- 3.2. Members and guests must be 21 years of age to purchase alcoholic beverages and must conform to BUCYC's alcoholic beverage policy. Intoxication will not be permitted. Therefore the Board of Directors authorize bartenders to refuse alcoholic service to any member or guest.
- 3.3. Alcoholic beverages consumed at the bar, clubhouse and surrounding grounds must be purchased at the bar, if it is open.
- 3.4. Proper attire is required. Wet clothes or swimsuits are not allowed in the bar or clubhouse. Dry swimsuits are permitted with a cover up for women and a T-shirt for men. Also, footwear is mandatory in the bar and clubhouse.
- 3.5. Cigarette, cigar and pipe smoking is prohibited in the bar and clubhouse.
- 3.6. No animals are allowed in the bar and clubhouse, with the exception of service animals. Service animals are not allowed at bar, food or beverage counters. Service animals must be under positive control of the owner at all times. The owner will be responsible for the service animal's actions and for cleaning up any defecation or for other damage to the facility caused by the service animal, up to and including professional cleaning or replacement damaged materials.
- 3.7. Requests for private use of the bar and/or the clubhouse must be made in advance in writing to the Commodore.
